Field Captain's responsibilities

1. The field must be roped off in accordance with the agreed plan (see notes below and plan overleaf) and all the signs are in place.
2. The targets are in the correct place on the range and are securely tied down.
3. All participating archers are suitably qualified.
4. The GNAS 'Rules of Shooting' are followed at all times.
5. Any 'lost' arrows should be located and removed before the field is vacated or if that has not proven possible a 'Lost arrow Report Form' should be completed and submitted to Crookham Village Parish Council. Further endeavours to find any 'lost' arrows should still continue at every opportunity.
6. All equipment to be removed from the field & checked back in (especially the boundary rope stakes).

Field layout notes:

1. Using goal line as datum:
 1. 100yds range:
 - a. Shooting line to be 30yds back
 - b. Boundary rope to be 38.4yds back
 2. 80yds range:
 - a. Shooting line to be 20yds back
 - b. Boundary rope to be 28.4yds back
2. Boundary rope to be:
 1. 10yds from corner of Play area
3. Gate in fence to be closed & secured with padlock & chain. Sign to be attached to gate.
4. Warning signs to be placed along boundary rope as marked on the plan.
